



## Public Health Direction—How does this affect Mini Golf...

The Public Health Direction becomes law at 5:00am on Friday 17th December 2021.

### Golf /Mini Golf Operations

- Unvaccinated people can play golf, including associated activities i.e. golf course practice facilities, mini golf etc
- Unvaccinated people can play golf in the same group as fully vaccinated people
- Unvaccinated people can share a golf cart with a vaccinated golfer
- Unvaccinated people can use the 'drinks cart' service
- Unvaccinated people can enter and use Proshop services
- Food and drink cannot be consumed in the Proshop

### Clubhouse

- Vaccinated patrons can use all hospitality services of a golf club/facility
- Unvaccinated patrons can enter the clubhouse to purchase take away food and drink to consume on the golf course and practice facilities. **They cannot eat and drink in the clubhouse or in any of the outdoor areas under the clubhouse footprint, such as the outdoor area at the western end of the clubhouse, the new deck area, the mini golf picnic seat area or the area under the shade sails to the eastern end of the clubhouse.**
- Unvaccinated patrons may enter the clubhouse building to use the toilets and may enter the locker rooms.

Everyone must check in using the Check In Qld app and ultimately have your vaccination certificate linked to the app (or a printed copy) to show proof of your double vaccination to staff on entry.

This is not a directive put in place by the club, this is a directive from the Queensland Government. Our staff are required to ask for proof of vaccination every time you enter the building. Please respect our staff, they are simply doing their job.
